How to borrow

Curtin University Staff and Students need a current University ID card to borrow.
Non-Curtin borrowers must come to the library help desk to make borrowing arrangements.

Some shelf numbers include a letter at the beginning of the number:

Q indicates that it is a large book (Quarto)- B a smaller booklet - P a journal - F with numbers a very large book (Folio) - F with letters fiction (F BAU) - R indicates an item from the Reference Collection.

The Library catalogue is available at any library PC or from your office or home through the internet.

You can check your loans, renew items, place a recall, and search other WA library catalogues.

Avoid overdue items by renewing your loans before they become overdue.

The Library does fine for overdue items and fine information is available on the Curtin Library home page.

Photocopying/Printing services/scanning

There are two card operated photocopiers in the Library. All computers in the Library are networked to printers. Curtin Staff and Students can register their ID card to use on these machines. Other Library Clients can purchase a copy card at the Library help desk. (Currently \$2.00ea). Easy to use scanners are attached to two PC's in the Library for Client use.

PC's and Electronic Information services

Library clients have access to 30 Library computers with Internet, MS Office etc.

There is wireless access available for Curtin Students and Staff. Information on how to connect can be found here: <http://cits.curtin.edu.au/> or please speak to staff at the library desk.

Students completing research/study have priority for using Library computers. Students using Library Computers must conform to Curtin University's policies for the appropriate use of University ICT facilities.

Study spaces within the Library (Includes individual and group study spaces)

There are individual study carrels and group tables available in the library. These do not require booking.

Room 107

This room is a small computer training room. Facilities include 8 computers on the library system and can be booked for group work. At all other opening times this room is available to all library clients for computer use.

Room 108

Is a small classroom (16-20 max) available for group study. The room has a DVD/Video and a data projector can be borrowed. Please book the room at the information/help desk.

The Library has a connection on the WESTLINK network in this room. Westlink bookings 90886630. If you wish to videotape a programme please supply your own cassette.

Rooms 103/104/105/106 (Small Study Booths)

There are 4 small study booths which accommodate 1-2 people for private study, these do not require booking. Swap your ID card for a key at the information/help desk in the Library.
