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Maximising the proportion of research freely available will raise the profile of Curtin as a research-intensive institution and demonstrate the University's commitment to the global movement to provide public access to publicly funded research. Open access is now mandated by many national and international funding agencies including the Australian Research Council and the National Health and Medical Research Council.

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
