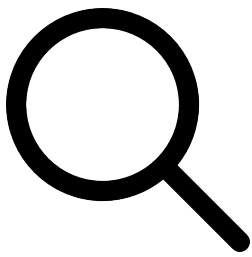




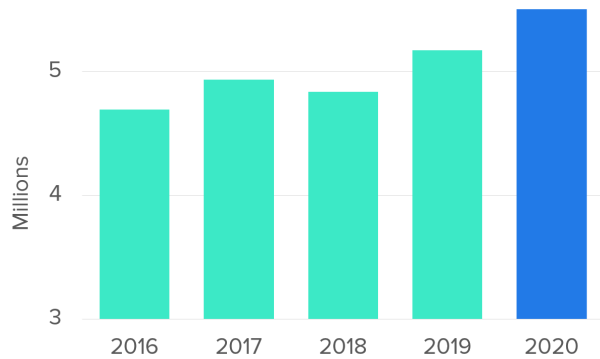

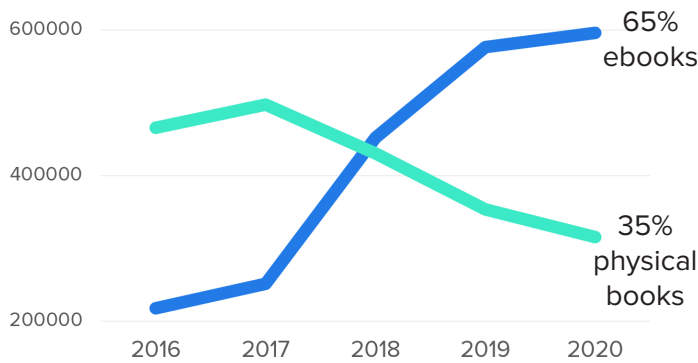


Our catalogue was searched over 4,800,000 times.

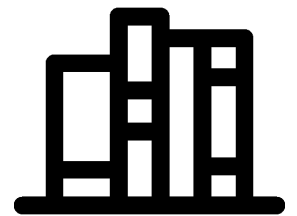


Our online journals, ebooks and databases were accessed over 5,740,000 times.

The proportion of ebooks in our collections has steadily increased, making our collection more equitable and accessible.



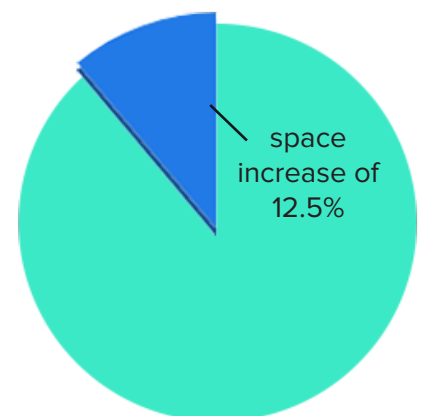
We hold over 8.5km of physical items, including books and journal articles.

Library spaces

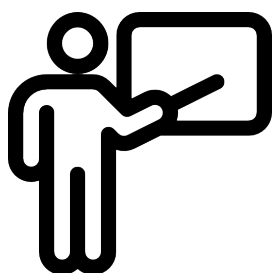


Our libraries are visited over 2,000,000 times a year.

The TL Robertson Library refurbishment will create over 2,000sqm of new usable floorspace adding to our 16,000sqm space.

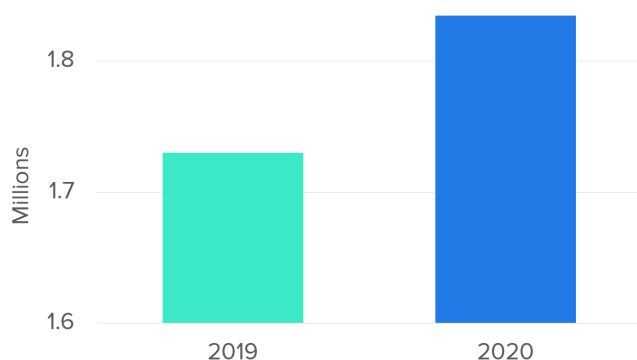

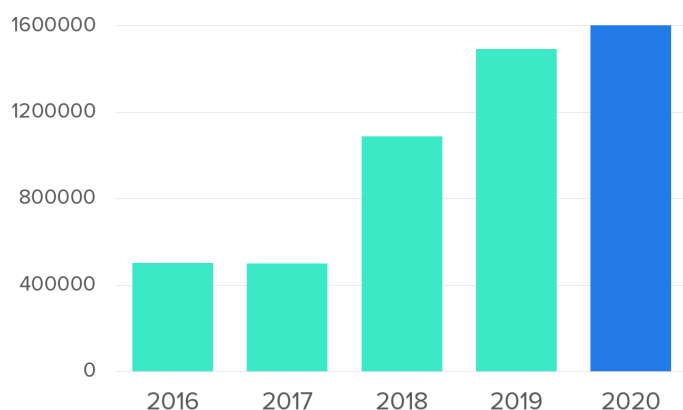


Our library and study skills workshops attracted almost 17,000 attendees.

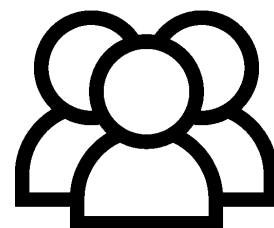
Pageviews on our online learning resources have increased by 104,000 since 2019.



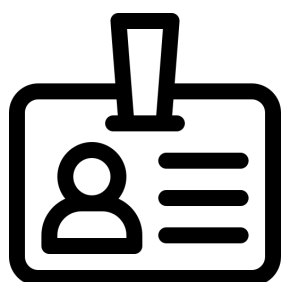

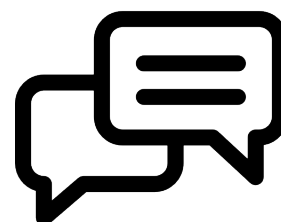
Since 2016, we've had over 5,100,000 downloads via espase, our institutional repository. 30% of total downloads occurred in 2020.
